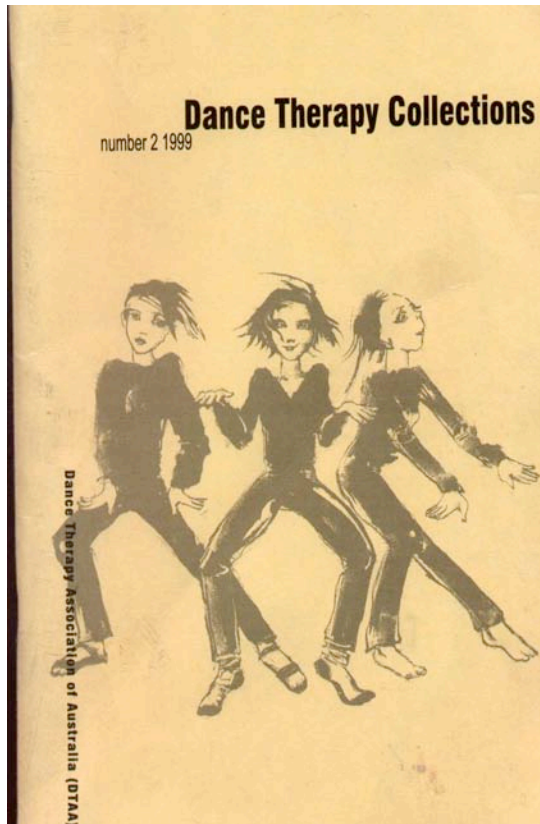


DANCE THERAPY COLLECTIONS
